## Our Learning this week

This week, in Learning Mission, Oak Class has focused on how different religions use art to portray their love for their specific gods. Through this they have been able to develop their knowledge and understanding of the reasons why holy buildings look the way they do.

In English, the children have created a setting description linked to two holy places, where pilgrimages are made to: The Blue Mosque and The Pilgrimage Church of Wies. As part of this, they have tried to evoke an image for the reader to be able to see, through their use of descriptive language.

In Maths, the children have applied their understanding area and perimeter by reasoning and problem solving. Along with this, they have learned how to calculate the volume of cubes and cuboids.
