




**Jolesfield CE Primary School**

**Weekly Overview**



**Year group: Reception and Year One**

**Date w/c: 24/2/20**

Area of learning	What we will be learning
Communication and Language Literacy (English) 	We shall be talking about different vehicles and how they move. Then based on our observations we shall be designing our own vehicle and making it. We shall be talking about what materials to use and how we shall fix them together. Once we have made our vehicle we will discuss what went well, what we would change and why.
Phonics 	Yr R: We shall be blending and segmenting the sounds we have learnt and learning 'ck', 'e' and 'u' (Group 1) and 'oo' (short and long sound) and 'ar' (Group 2). Yr 1: The children in Year One will be continuing with Phase 5 phonics.
Mathematical Development	Yr R will be learning the names of 3D and 2D shape as part of DT week and sorting them. Y1 will be learning to describe the properties of 3D and 2D shape as part of DT week.
Personal, Social, and Emotional Development	We shall be learning about turn taking and sharing materials and equipment whilst we make our vehicles.
Expressive Arts and Design	We shall be planning, designing and making a moving vehicle.
Understanding of the world	We shall be learning about how vehicles move and why they are designed in a particular way.
Physical Development 	In PE we will be focusing on dance this half term. We will be thinking about how different dinosaurs might move and using these movements to create a short sequence to music. <b>Changing clothes:</b> Thank you to everyone who is encouraging your children to get themselves dressed and undressed at home. Not only is this an important part of children developing independence at this age, it is also important in practical terms. We have two adults to help 22 Reception children, therefore they need to do the majority of the changing without support. Thank you.

**DT WEEK - (WEEK BEGINNING 24TH FEBRUARY)**

Our focus will be vehicles and how they move. The children will be designing their own moving vehicle together with axles and wheels and then using their plan to make it. We would be extremely grateful if you could provide your child with a cardboard box for their vehicle.
