Don't forget **World Book Day** is next Thursday. This year our theme is The Bible and we will be dressing as characters from that book. The staff have been busy sorting through the Christmas costumes in the vain hope that one of them might fit – so watch this space!

This week we have started our Fun & Fitness and Gym clubs with Pacesetters. Both of the coaches commented on the excellent attitude of the children and their abilities, and the children have all told me that the clubs were brilliant.

Next Friday we have the first of our Open Assemblies for this term. As there is now gym club on a Friday we will be unable to set up the hall until after this has finished. We will open the door to parents as soon as possible but there may be a short wait – apologies if the weather is unkind.

Weekly music: This week we have been listening to Mozart's Horn Concerto. Mozart wrote his manuscript for this work in red, green, blue and black inks, and it was generally considered as a wind-up to unsettle the original horn player, his friend Joseph Leutgeb. However, it's recently been suggested that it may even be a kind of a code. In the third movement Mozart is obviously evoking the thrill of the hunt, with the horn echoing the sound and tone of the hunting horn and its open-air calls. Can you find any other hunting themed music?
