## Prime Areas

In Communication and Language, the children have been retelling the story and verbally ordering and sequencing before attempting to write.

In PSED, the children have been learning about healthy eating on the Life Bus. The children really enjoyed meeting Harold the Giraffe.

In Expressive Arts and Design, the children have been making models of the Three Little Pigs' houses.

In Understanding the World, we have looked at the different materials needed to build a house and why they are best.

## Specific Areas

In Literacy this week, the children have read the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. They have been using story language, 'Once upon a time..' to write their own versions of the story.

In Phonics, the children have been recapping sounds in Phase 3.

In Maths, the children have been learning how to double numbers to 10. They have used multilink cubes, numicon pieces and lots of pictures to help with this. We have also recorded the number sentences.

This week we had a visit from the Life Bus, where all of the children enjoyed meeting Harold the Giraffe!
