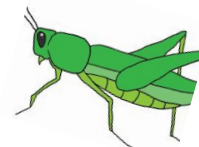

Area of learning	What we will be learning
English	<p>Reading – This week we are going to be introduced to The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We are going to look at the front cover and read a small extract. We will be asking questions to gather more information. We will then be looking at the text in detail, predicting what might happen next as well as summarising main ideas. There will be a group each day working with Mrs Parr on each part of the text.</p> <p>Writing – Our writing will also be based around The Iron Man. We are going to be using drama to support our understanding and descriptions of what is happening in the first part of the chapter. We are going to be learning about similes, possessive apostrophes and using fronted adverbials. This will help us write our own character description next week.</p>
Spellings	<p>Group 1 - Scent, sent, vain, vein, rode and road Group 2 - Centre, century, certain, recent and notice Spelling test this Friday for the above words - your child should know which set of spellings they are focusing on. New words will be sent home on Friday.</p>
Maths	<p>This week in maths we are going to be focusing on fractions. We are going to be reminding ourselves of equivalent fractions and building upon our learning from Year 3.</p>
Topic	<p>Our French lessons on Tuesday will resume this week. We are going to be picking up where we left off with our topic How does it work? We are going to be focusing on forces and magnets in Science this half term. Mrs Carey will be covering PPA on a Tuesday afternoon teaching art and music.</p>
Homework	<p>Homework will be collected on Tuesday. Thank you to those who have already handed in your evaluation sheets. It's been lovely reading the comments. If you haven't handed in your DT evaluation form, please make sure this is handed in.</p>
Any Other Information	<p>World Book Day is on Thursday 5th March 2020. We will be off timetable on this day to celebrate our love of books. We will be sharing books on Thursday so if your child would like to bring in their favourite book then you are welcome to do this.</p>
