Medical Appointments/Absence

Can we please ask that if your child has a medical appointment during the school day that you show the school office proof: a text, email or letter to avoid your child getting an unauthorised mark on the register. If your child is absent from school you need to tell the school office before 09.30am and give the reason for the absence. Any children who are arriving late to school after 09.10am will have to sign in and will get a late mark on the register.
