Celebrations of Learning

Village Hall

Please can parents/carers **NOT** use the village hall car park for dropping off/picking up children. The car park between the village hall and the pharmacy is a public car park and anyone can park there. The car park on the other side of the village hall (before the hall, on the left as you go up Green Lane) is a private car park and **MUST NOT** be used. People have parked there and blocked the fire escape which is a hazard for anyone using the village hall.

Absence, Illness and Appointments

There will be times when illness or other exceptional circumstances make it impossible for your child to attend school. If your child is absent, please let the office staff know by 9:00am **every school day** throughout the absence. **Please do not use Class Dojo as a form of communication for illness.** As a matter of school policy, if your child is absent and you have not informed the school, then we will make a call to enquire about your child's absence. If your child will be off school at any time for an appointment, please let the school office know and if a school dinner will need to be ordered for them on their return.

Class Photographs

It is class group photographs on Monday, 16 March. If you **DO NOT** wish for your child to take part, please make sure that you let the class teacher know.

Late Arrivals

On the last week of term there was **27 late arrivals** for school. When children arrive late it impacts not only the child's learning but also the interruption for classes. It also can have a detrimental impact on the child's well-being as they may feel embarrassed walking into their class as all the other children will have already started their learning. Please can you ensure that your child arrives on time for school each day.

Dinner Money

The cost of a school dinner is £2.10 per day, £10.50 for a full school week and £63.00 for the term up to the Easter Holidays. Please put money in an envelope/money bag with your child's name and class and ask them to put it in their register basket. If you pay by cheque, please make payable to Tupton Primary and Nursery Academy.

Clothing in the Colder Weather

Please remember to send your child with appropriate clothing including sweatshirts or cardigans, coats, and when necessary hat, scarf and gloves so children can play outside at break and lunch times. A reminder: children are allowed to wear a watch and stud ear-rings (children must be able to remove their own earrings for PE and swimming), no other jewellery is permitted. Make-up and nail polish is not to be worn at school.
