**Weekly music:** This week we have been listening to Edward Elgar's Pomp and Circumstance March. In his lifetime, Elgar completed 5 marches, with the first 4, including the most famous first, the 'Land of Hope and Glory' march coming between 1901 and 1907, long before the harsh realities of the First World War changed many British people's attitudes to war. Giving words to the middle section was a suggestion by King Edward VII for his coronation. We are using ABRSM Classical 100.
