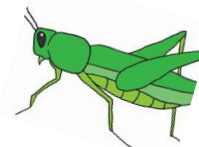

Area of learning	What we will be learning
English	<p>Reading – We are continuing to read The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We are going to be making inferences based on what has been read as well as increasing our familiarity with the text.</p> <p>Writing – This week we are going to be reading a selection of character descriptions to analyse what makes a great narrative. We are going to spend some time planning our own description before we peer assess the work. We are going to be looking at how effective our writing is and respond to peer feedback.</p>
Spellings	Group 1 - Scheme, chorus, echo, ache and chaos Group 2 - Medicine, circle, decide, exercise and special Spelling test this Friday for the above words - your child should know which set of spellings they are focusing on. New words will be sent home on Friday.
Maths	This week in maths we are going to be focusing on fractions. We are going to be looking at fractions that are greater than one. We will also be learning how to add and subtract fractions with the denominator staying the same.
Topic	Our French lessons continue on Tuesday morning - last week we learnt about the names of animals. Mrs Carey will continue to teach art and music on Tuesday afternoon. In RE we are focusing on the BIG question of: <i>Why do Christians call the day Jesus died Good Friday?</i>
Homework	Homework will be collected on Tuesday.
Any Other Information	Reminder: Parent's Evening is this week on Tuesday and Thursday.
