Dear Parents,

The briefing from Government after Thursday's COBRA meeting, indicates that for the time being schools across the UK will remain open as usual. **If your children present with symptoms of the Coronavirus - a new, continuous cough, shortness of breath and high temperature - you should keep them at home for 7 days to self-isolate and phone the school to let us know.** You should not go to a GP surgery, pharmacy or hospital. You do not need to contact 111 to tell them you're staying at home. Any decisions about school closures will be in line with Government guidance however in the meantime we will be working with our Academy partners to create work packs that we will provide for your children in the event that a school closure is announced. Please take care with information on social media where there seems to be a lot of unhelpful speculation.

All being well, I hope to see many of you at our phonics and multiplication workshops next week and don't forget, next Tuesday is a green themed non-uniform day with chocolate donations for our Easter Bingo events.
