Why should I download the app?
This innovative app keeps parents engaged by sending all the essential information straight to your phone. You will have access to regularly updated information:



Everything in one app!

How do I download the app?

Android users Go to Google Play, search for School Jotter or scan the QR code.

iOS users Go to the App Store and search for School Jotter or scan the QR code.

Our mobile app is available to use and we would encourage all parents to download it as soon as possible.

There is a QR link on the information circulated (also included later in this newsletter), or you can search for School Jotter on the relevant app store.

You will be able to access the calendar, newsletters, notices, etc. The app will be used for group and individual messaging in the very near future.

A separate letter for individual parents has been sent out (in envelopes) which provides login details to allow use of the messaging part of the app. This will replace the texting system used previously, so we would ask all parents to engage with this.

Friday 20th March – Mother's Day Service in Church 2:15pm

Parents are invited to attend our Mother's Day service in church at 2:15pm. Children can go straight home from church with parents following the service. Any parents who are able to walk up to church with the children are asked to let the office know. Thanks.

Tuesday 31st March – Y6 SAT's Information Session for Parents 6pm

Parents of children in Year 6 and parents of children in Year 5 who would like to know more are invited to attend an information session about the national assessments that Year 6 children will be taking in the week commencing 11th May. This session includes an opportunity to see examples of test papers and discuss how to best support your child in the run up to the assessments.
