Daily tasks

Reading

Read a school reading book or another book for 20 minutes, twice a day. It will help to read to an adult for one of these sessions each day. In addition, please complete the reading comprehensions you have been given.

Spelling

Practise your spellings for 10 minutes using "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check."
