



Year 5 - How to keep learning at home

While you are not able to be in school, we want to reduce the interruption to your learning. Below are some tasks that you should carry out to maintain your progress. For each subject we have suggested some activities for you.

Daily tasks

Reading

Read a school reading book or another book for 20 minutes, twice a day. It will help to read to an adult for one of these sessions each day.

Spelling & Grammar

Practise your spellings for 10 minutes using "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check." If you have access to a computer, laptop or tablet you could work on Spelling City (www.spellingcity.com)

Maths

Practise your tables for 10 minutes.
