



## Year 4 - How to keep learning at home

### Daily tasks

#### Reading

Read your school reading book or another book for 20 minutes, twice a day. It will help to read to an adult for one of these sessions each day.

#### Spelling

Practise your spellings for 10 minutes using "Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check."
