### PARTIAL CLOSURE AT MAY PARK FROM 23<sup>RD</sup> March 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the recent announcement from the Rt Hon Gavin Williamson – Secretary of State for Education we will **partially close** May Park Primary on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020.

The school will be closed for the majority of our children except for the children of key workers and vulnerable children. The Secretary of state description of key workers includes **“NHS staff, police and supermarket delivery drivers”** and vulnerable children as **“those who have a social worker and those with Education, Health and Care Plans”**. We expect more information on eligible children later today but until then we would also like to include children **entitled to Free School Meals** on the list as well. If your child falls into one of these categories and you wish to attend next week, we would appreciate an expression of interest so that we can ensure adequate staffing. Please contact the office for a form.

If your child **does not** fall into one of these categories we would appreciate your support in keeping your child at home. Remaining at home will help to minimize large scale contact with others and hopefully slow the spread of COVID 19. Work is available on our website to support home learning – tab COVID 19. Here you will find information about the work set by teachers. There are also Year Group Tabs with worksheets and other activities for children to complete at home. We will continue to add work to these tabs in the event of extended closure.
