

Nursery Newsletter

This week, we have continued learning about eggs. Our book of the week was 'Hank finds an egg', a lovely story about how a little bear finds an egg and takes care of it whilst trying to work out how to get it safely back to its nest high in the tree. The story has no words so we needed to be authors and make the story ourselves. We were very good at following the pictures and talking about what was happening in them.

We sequenced the pictures from the story into the right order.

In maths we have been looking at 3D shapes. We investigated which shapes were best for rolling or stacking and why. We talked about the shapes of the different faces of the solid 3D shapes and used language such as round, curved, flat, straight.

In phonics we have started listening for alliteration. We sang a song called 'My Little Ear' (like I Spy) and investigated the different items in our sound boxes in order to practise hearing the beginning sound in objects.

In the play dough we have been inspired to make beautiful, feathery creatures. In the workshop we have been making nests for the eggs. We used grass, sticks and string. Some of us were very good and bending and twisting the twigs to make our nests.

We have also been talking about how important it is to wash our hands after play and before we eat. We carried out an activity where we all put a post it note of ourselves onto a bus. Then the Shrek character sneezed (squirty water bottle). He didn't put his hand or elbow over his mouth and we saw how all the germs travelled onto the passengers!
