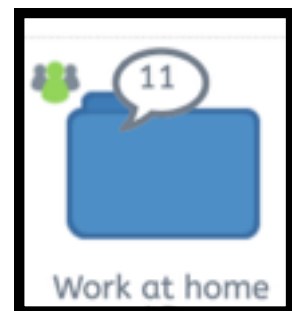
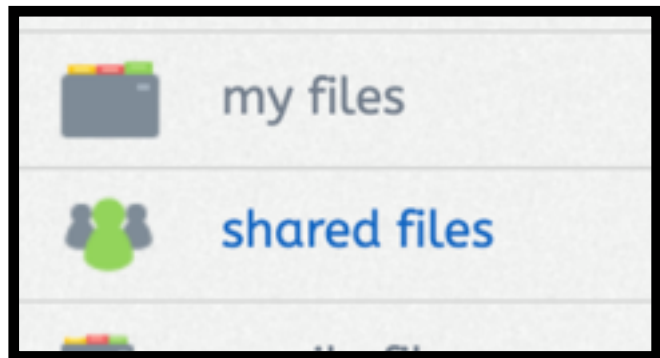

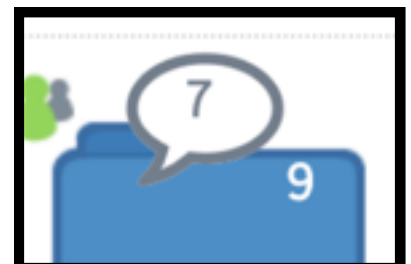
o dan enw ei dd/dosbarth (Ilun 2).

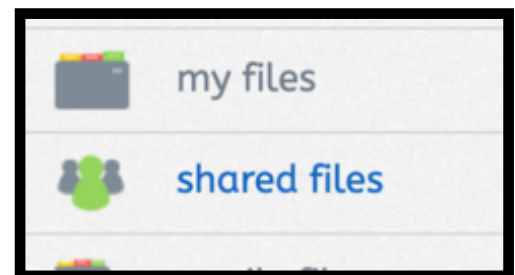

the teachers.



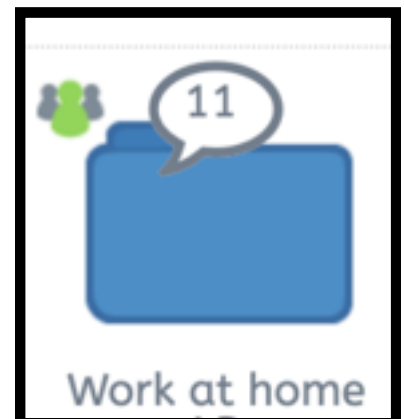
Hello everyone! Here's just a little reminder to you all that there is a way to share your children's work with the teachers (junior department only, at the moment) through J2E on Hwb. Work has been shared with your child's class, and there is a folder within their 'Shared files' / 'Ffeiliau wedi rhannu' (photo 1)



within J2E under his/her class name (photo 2).



All computer work can be shared straight into the 'Work at home' folder (photo 3) within their 'My files'/'Fy ffeiliau' area.



If possible, you could also photograph any work your child has done on paper, and upload that photo to the 'Work at home' folder as well. The teachers will then be able to communicate / feed back about your child's work through the 'speech bubble'/learning discussion (picture 4). Many children have already done this ... well done!
