<p>School to assess the rate of pupil progress on a termly basis and overall to the end of the year against targets agreed for pupils based on making at least expected rates of progress in all areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School data for the end of 2012 shows pupils eligible for PPG funding made progress at least equal to that of other pupils overall.</li> <li>• Average point progress for identified children was: maths 4.77p, writing 4.0pt and reading was 3.73pt.</li> </ul>
