Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: School reopening announcement

Many of you will have heard the Prime Minister's announcement and his plans for opening primary schools to some year groups (Reception, Year 1 and Year 6) from 1st June.

At this stage I would like to remind you:

1. Nothing has changed yet – school is still closed (for most pupils) and you should continue to keep your child at home. Please continue home learning as much as is possible for you.
2. Schools, including us here at West Acton, have also only just heard this news at the same time as you, so at the moment I cannot give you any further information or answers to questions that you may have.
3. We will await further advice from the Government and work with the local authority on details and I will inform you as soon as possible.
4. The safety of everyone remains our priority.

I want nothing more than our school to be open and full of life and learning and look forward to returning to this: when it is safe to do so. I will provide further information in the coming days and weeks as I am able to.

In the meantime please stay at home as much as possible and stay safe.
