Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Learning during the school closure

Firstly, I would like to say a huge well done and thank you to parents/carers, staff and children for working so hard on their teaching and learning whilst school has been closed, which it has now been for four weeks. Everyone, including staff and families, has a different set of circumstances, resources and expectations and meeting them all, virtually, is a challenging task. This means that every school is supporting their families in different ways. At West Acton, we follow guidance on safeguarding and GDPR from the Government, Union advice for staff and try to consider everyone's wellbeing. I thought it would be good time to remind you of resources that are available and a couple of new features we are introducing.

Currently we offer:

1. Bespoke daily lessons from our teachers for each class and whole school Head teacher messages Each year group and myself, post daily work and messages for pupils and parents/carers. Please check here daily to keep up with what is going on. The content remains in there so you can dip in and out as you wish

3. Paper packs that we gave before the school closure

A simple paper pack was given to all pupils who were present in school before we closed. We cannot post these packs out to everyone. If you did not collect your pack and would like to collect it staff will be able to hand these out to you at set times next week.

- 1. Do not come to get a pack if you already have it we have a list and know who took theirs home.
- 2. There are no new packs to collect so please do not come and ask for something else.
- 3. Do not come in large family groups, please respect social distancing when waiting for your pack and respect the staff who may have to ask you to move or stand back.
- 4. The pack is quite simple booklet of reading, writing and maths exercises please consider if you really need to come and collect or are you doing ok with the online resources?
- 5. Staff handing these out will not be able to discuss your child's learning with you.
- 6. Think carefully before you come to collect this.

2. Interactive Teacher Sessions – a live wall!

Following the success and positive feedback from our shared online learning file, which contains simple lessons and activities, we are now expanding our online support by offering short interactive sessions with teachers across our school. This will be a live wall where you can type questions to a teacher.

Starting from Monday 4th May, these interactive sessions will take place for 1 hour each school day between 10.00am and 11.00am and will provide an opportunity to ask any questions that you have during the closure period. The teacher(s) running each session will be answering questions across all year group 'chats' and may not necessarily be your child's class teacher.

For online safety, we have taken the following precautions:

- USO usernames and passwords will be required to access each year group 'chat'
- Children's names will not be displayed within the 'chat'; their USO username will be used instead. Please ask your child not to disclose their name within the 'chat'.
- Video conferencing has been disabled; any videos shown by teachers will have been pre-recorded.
- 1:1 chat, whether student to student or teacher to student, has been disabled.
- Work can still be submitted privately via the 'Assignment' feature and any additional queries can still be to



2) You may then be prompted to download the app or use the web Please choose the option that you would prefer – both should work effectively.




