Hello to all our families, **Important information about reopening:**

During the week, conversations amongst the senior leadership of the school, governors and local heads have been ongoing in light of the most recently information available.

As of 26.5.20 we know:-

1. [The Independent SAGE Report 2](#) published on 22.5.20 indicates clearly, on page 2 & 3, that if schools open on 15th June the risk of infection is reduced by 50% compared with opening on 1st June. This is a compelling piece of scientific evidence.
2. One of the 5 key tests the government insisted must be in place before schools open is the test, track and trace. It is essential that this is embedded practice before school opens.
3. The school risk assessment is currently with our quality assurance partners—the Local Authority and school staff representatives. As part of this process there will be actions for the school to undertake and this will take a few days.
4. Finally, further government guidance for opening EYFs issued on Sunday 24th May has other specifications that must be met.

It is becoming increasingly clear that Eastland's cannot open on 2nd June as expected. Please accept my apologies as I can imagine some of you will have work plans and commitments.

New reopening dates:-

School is now planning to open for Nursery, Rec, yr1 and yr6 on Monday 15th June.

- ◆ **Group 1**— will return to school beginning: **15.06.20 (Mon-Thurs) & 29.6.20 (M-Thur)**
- ◆ **Group 2**- will return on the week beginning: **22.6.20 (Mon-Thurs) & 06.7.20 (M-Thur)**
- ◆ **Year 6** -will be in from **15th June**.
- ◆ **Dates for other years groups will be determined once we have opened on 15th June.**

Again, this is all dependent on the latest advice that is made available to schools and the situation may change further.
