Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to all families whether remotely or back at school for some children. We have been extremely busy planning and preparing the school for the safest return possible for children, parents and staff. As you most probably could see from the health and safety video I made to show the measures that have been put into place, to comply with guidance necessary for the safest return, it certainly does compromise the space and staff we have available and unfortunately it will be necessary to limit spaces.

We would be grateful, if you are choosing to send your child in, please do let the school know in advance.

Although we are opening up for our phased return at the beginning of this term, initially starting with our group of year 6 children, it is not compulsory for children to attend. Children who are considered extremely clinically vulnerable and shielding should not attend. Parents of children who have a health condition that makes them vulnerable and is at higher risk of severe illness from Coronavirus should seek and follow medical advice.



We will continue to provide online provision for all children, so that parents who choose to keep their children at home are not disadvantaged, as we recognise that each family has individual circumstances to consider. We are adjusting and refining as we go and working with all of our families to provide the best possible support we can offer during this challenging time.

We are continually tracking the children who have accessed remote provision, and have benefitted from this provision and learning experience throughout school closure. Please do contact the school if you need support with this, where we will endeavour to help you and guide you as best we can, so that children are not disadvantaged by not accessing this learning provision.


