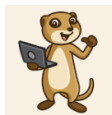

### RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN

As from 8th June, our Reception children have been attending school everyday in 'bubbles' of 8. The Year 1 pupils joined us on 15th June and the Year 6 pupils return on 22nd June. **It is wonderful to have the children back in school.** A risk assessment has been carried out and verified by all staff and governors and the process agreed by Derbyshire County Council.

There has to be a staggered start and end to the school day, and also at lunchtime.—this ensures that the different groups of children do not meet and thus the risk of cross-contamination is reduced.

**We cannot guarantee that the children within the small groups will maintain social distancing at all times, however, by keeping them in the same small groups with the same staff, we are reducing the risk.**
