I hope that you continue to be safe and well during the continuing Covid-19 situation.

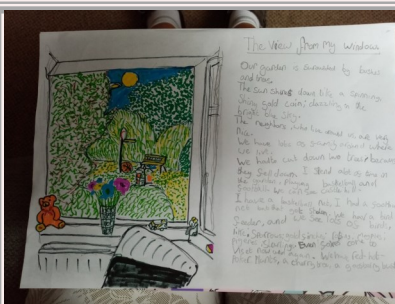

## Transition

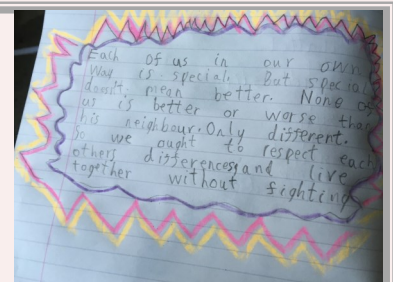
