### Phased Reopening of Schools

Should the plan to re-open schools from after half term go ahead, due to a reduction in virus infections and deaths, plans for the school will be **VERSION A** below. If the Government announce that this re-opening will not go ahead, plans for the school will be **VERSION B** below. Please aware of both sets of plans in case any changes are made right at the end of May. We have been informed that maybe only 48 hours' notice would be given so we may not have much time to let you know. **Unfortunately, due to the continuing low numbers using Grover Club before and after school, they will now be closing for the rest of the summer term.**

#### VERSION A

**School is Re-Opening to F1 and F2:**

**Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June is an INSET day.** No children on site.

**Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> June onwards:** Plans for re-opening begin as detailed in letters sent to each parent. Please refer to your letter to know where to bring your children to and collect them from.

**Key worker Children** onsite 8.00-4.00. F1 children (non-keyworker) on site 8.30-2.30. F2 children (on-keyworker) on site 9.00-2.45 or 9.15-3.00. **Grover is not on site at all.**

#### VERSION B

**School is not able to Re-Open to more children:**

**Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June onwards:** Key Worker and Vulnerable children **ONLY** on site with school staff from 8.00-4.00- please come to the main entrance to be registered and taken to class. Please observe social distancing in the car park as you wait to come in. **Grover is not on site at all.**
