End of year reports

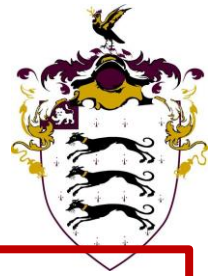
The end of year reports will be out next Monday (29th June) via email.
