Blue Peter's 6 Badges of Summer: Music

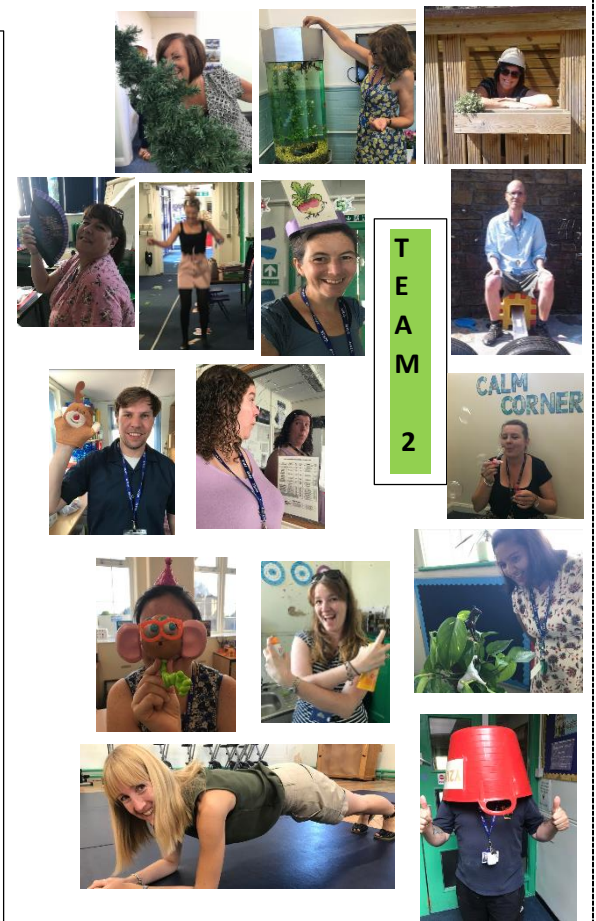
