- Do not leave home if you or someone you live with has either of the main symptoms

However difficult it is to self-isolate it is important that we all do what we can to ensure we reduce the spread of the virus and keep everyone's loved ones safe. The quicker we can stop the spread the quicker we will all be able to get back to our 'normal' daily routines.
