Re-opening School

As you are aware we are continuing to make plans to re-open the school on 1st June providing the Government still say it is safe and their criteria has been met.

Following the Governments guidelines we have decided that in the first instance we will not be offering Year 6 a provision in school due to the amount of classrooms that we have available and the class 'bubbles' that we need to create. (The Government requires schools to ensure the youngest children have a space first!)

If/when the Government decide that social distancing is not required and we can fit more children in each classroom we will then be in a position to invite more year groups back to school. Although we will closely follow any advice given we will always ensure the safety of our pupils and staff.

Further information will be sent out this week stating which classes the children will be in and what their starting/finishing times will be.

There will be no breakfast club or after school clubs from 1st June until further notice.

We will also be expecting parents to adhere to strict social distancing expectations on the school site and that they stick to the timings given. This will include ensuring no one stays around on the school grounds to talk or play after their children have been collected or dropped off.

Please note that next week is Spring Bank half term and the teachers and pupils holiday. Therefore the staff will be having a much needed break and no work will be posted on Google Classroom during the week holiday.

Online learning will continue from 1st June for the pupils who will still be learning from home.
