We are immensely proud of the Eco Warriors' work and now look forward to hosting a Royal Institution in Science Day at school.



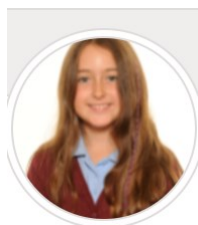
## Record of Achievements
