

Update

We have had a really productive week in school, the children have been so sensible and mature about how school is operating at the moment. If you want to see what the children have been doing, there are lots of slideshows on our school website.

As you know we are living in an ever changing world at the moment, so with this in mind I wanted to update you on a few changes we have made in preparation for September. School will reopen on Thursday 3rd September to children in all year groups. We are excited to announce that they will return to their current class for 2 days. They will enjoy spending time with their current teacher and children that they know.

Over these 2 days, we will complete some transition sessions so as to prepare your child for moving up in to their new class and with their new teacher the following week. (Monday 7th September). Our reasoning behind doing this is related to closure for both teacher and child and also to alleviate any anxiety of the unknown over the summer break.

Further guidance from the Government was released yesterday with regards to what schooling will look like in September. We need to plan for staggered starts/finish times and break/ lunch times. We will put together a letter informing you of all the details and this will be emailed out to you next week. In addition to this, the Local Authority are also producing a letter and once we have received it, we will email it to you. Finally, reports will be sent out, via post or email if you have requested this, on **Wednesday 8th July.**

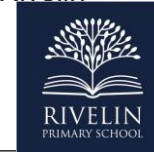
SEND Questionnaire
