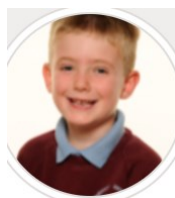

Gold Award

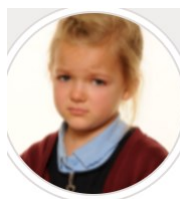
A huge WELL DONE to Luke Watson,
