Each year we need to make sure we have accurate contact details and privacy permissions from parents. To help us in our quest to become a paperless school and make systems more robust, we are beginning to collect this information electronically this year.

You will soon be sent a letter about the SIMS APP we are now using. The Schools Information Management System (SIMS) is our comprehensive database of information about the children and staff. By having your own access to your data via the APP, you can ensure we always have the most up to date information about your child and family. Too often we find that we have old phone numbers for parents and cannot contact them when needed in an urgent situation. We are also sending a link to an Information Collection Survey, where you can give your permission, or not, to vital things we face regularly in school such as; the use of photos, internet, first aid application, educational visits and much more.
