Dear parents / carers,

This week, we've had about 25 children in school, and all of our staff are now back in too. Staff have been finishing off their work for this year, and starting to prepare for next school year, as well completing training relating to the COVID-19 situation and risk assessments.

This week / early next week, you will receive your child's school report (not for nursery children). If you have any questions about them at all, please ring school and ask to speak to your child's teacher; they will be able to help you.

If you have a child in Y1 – Y6 next year, they will all be **due back in school on Wednesday, September 2nd, 2020**. The government has announced that all children will be expected to be back in school (unless the situation changes) and fines will be issued to parents / carers who do not send their children back.

If you have a child due to join either nursery or reception in September, you will be getting a letter this week / at the start of next week, letting you know the arrangements for them starting. Because of the pandemic, we are going to organise this a little differently in September, to make sure that children get the best possible start to their time in school during these strange and difficult times.
