Zoom Space Information

In order to ensure everyone has a safe, enjoyable experience, the following measure will be in place during the Y6 Virtual Leaver's Party on Zoom:

- A new meeting room will be used. Parents will receive an email with log-in information before the event. Please use only one device per party household, to help limit feedback.
- Attendees will not be able to join before the host is present.
- Attendees will be muted on joining.
- When joining, your child must use their first name. E.g. 'Emma'
- Screen sharing will be turned off.
- The link will not be publicised on any social media.
- The meeting room will be locked once the event has started.

We also wish to inform you that staff will be closely monitoring and managing the room. If needed, attendees will be removed. Inappropriate actions will not be accepted. Children should not share any private information.
