School Uniform

From September 2019, we introduced a new school uniform which was compulsory for all of the new Reception children, and new starters. The uniform was optional for all of the remaining children in school. We were pleased to see there was a good uptake of the new uniform.

The intention was that the old uniform would be phased out, therefore from September this year, children will no longer be wearing the old style burgundy or blue sweatshirts, and will be required to wear a navy blue v-neck jumper or cardigan. Your child may wear the jumper/cardigan with or without the school logo. It remains optional for the children who will move into years 2 – 6 to wear the new style tartan skirt or pinafore or a plain grey skirt or pinafore.

Our new uniform is available from Moonline Uniforms on Standish Street in Burnley. The uniform consists of:

- Tartan Tie
- Navy v-neck jumper or cardigan (with or without logo)
- Tartan skirt or pinafore
- White shirt
- Grey trousers or skirt
- Black shoes
