## Arrangements for September

I am sure you are aware that the government have released guidance around schools reopening to all pupils in September. I can confirm that Hill View Juniors intends to reopen to ALL pupils on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

Mrs Sutton and Mrs Ross have been working very closely and have provisional plans in place that they wanted to share with you before the end of term. As I am sure you can appreciate the guidance changes regularly, risk assessments need to be rewritten and practicalities of lunchtime arrangements and breakfast and after school clubs still need to be worked through. Please keep checking the school jotter app and website over the 6 weeks holiday as this is where further information will be found.

In summary school will have staggered start and finish times, and a one way system onto and off the yard. Please only one adult on the yard per child, and it is not essential that children are brought onto the yard as there will be staff supervising, similarly pupils do not need to be collected from the yard, they will be escorted up the bank by staff. We would ask that your child only comes onto the yard at their allocated time to allow for social distancing
