Timings and expectations for September

Dear parents and carers

We have put in place plans to keep children, staff and families safe when all pupils return to school in September. We will build on our successful practice which has seen, at different points during the term, 229 pupils learning on site safely.

We hope that there will be even less coronavirus around in September, but it is important to remember that many members of our school community may still be vulnerable and so I do ask you to respect each other's safety by adhering strictly to our drop off and collection times and not congregating on the school site.

September start

Term starts for all children on **Thursday 3rd September**.

Starting with two half days:

To allow children who have been out of school for a long time to have a successful re-integration to school, *the first two days, Thursday 3rd and 4th September, are 'mornings only'*. On these days, you will need to pick your child up at the end of morning school at the times below. (I will use the afternoon time to meet with staff to review our arrangements once the children have been in.)

We will then continue with full days from Monday 7th September using the staggered times below.

Staggered start and end times:

To reduce the number of people on site and to keep both children and adults safe, we will have staggered start and end times for the children. We are aware that, for some families with children in different classes, you may have a waiting period between the classes. We trust that you can bear with this in order to keep yourselves and others safe.

These staggered times fit nicely with the 'soft start' approach that the infants school will be using as you will be able to drop off siblings at the infant school immediately after dropping off your junior children here. (Similarly, in the afternoon you will be able to collect your children at the infant school before collecting your children here at their allocated time.)
