The Weekly Offertory Collection will not be taken in the usual way at the present time but please leave your collection in the baskets either at the right side of the altar rails or at the side door as you leave church. Any donations towards church expenses are welcome and can be posted through the Presbytery letterbox.

Holy Communion: People should wait in their pews until instructed to move forward by the Stewards. The communicant should unloop their face covering and extend their hands to receive Holy Communion. They should then immediately consume the Sacred Host and replace their face covering before moving back to their seats following the one-way route via the Confessionals.

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: this year the Solemn Marian feast of 15th August will be kept on Sunday 16th August at 11.00am with the Vigil on Saturday evening at 6.30pm. The feast was indicated as early as 451. It was celebrated in the East by 602 and in Rome from 687 and then in the eighth century the feast was given the title of the Assumption of the BVM. The uninterrupted tradition of the Church is the basis for the celebration of Mary's assumption into heaven, body and soul. Ephesus is most likely the place where Mary died and the opening prayer at Holy Mass reads "God, you raised the sinless Virgin Mary, Mother of your Son, body and soul to the glory of heaven." In the Preface of the Mass it clearly states the constant faith of the Church: "You would not allow decay to touch her body, for she had given birth to your Son, the Lord of all life." The link between Mary and the Church is clearly expressed in the Prayer after Communion, we ask to "be led to the glory of heaven by the prayers of the Virgin Mary. In the Assumption we celebrate "the pattern of the Church in its perfection, and a sign of hope and comfort for your people on their pilgrim way." *Mary, our Mother, pray for us.*
