Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome back—we are so happy to see our children again and to reconnect with our families. We recognise that it has been a long time for our children to have been at home, and we fully appreciate that this may present some challenges at school—but we are ready to support and engage with our children to ensure we provide the very best for them.

Thank you for being so flexible when it comes to our staggered entry and exit times, we do appreciate it. It is not a perfect system, but with everyone arriving at their allotted time and leaving promptly, it is helping reduce congestion.

One area that we know is difficult is the narrow passageway through to the playground that is used at the end of the day for pick-up times. To try and address this we are implementing a one-way system for picking up children. Parents and carers will come in via the side gate at their staggered pick-up time, but instead of leaving the premises the same way, we ask that you use the footpath past the EYFS classroom that takes you round to the smaller EYFS side gate. This will ease any congestion and the need to pass in a narrow space as the path takes you past the car park and leads to the path along the front of the school. If the foot traffic is going in the same direction, it is much easier to keep a safe distance. Our EYFS pupils would have already been picked up and left the site by this time.

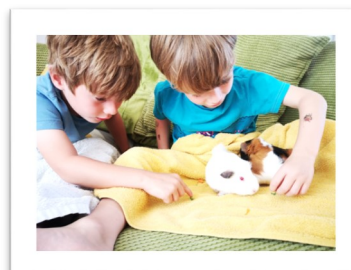
Please continue to use the **one-way system at the front of the school too**, as it will avoid close contact at the end of the public pathway. Can I please respectfully remind all our visitors that it is our duty to continue to try and keep a safe distance from others. I do understand that some families need to be on site longer to drop-off multiple children, but if you are able to go, please do so to leave room for others. I also understand how nice it is to reconnect with people and to catch up, but please do this away from our school site where others are trying to drop-off their children whilst maintaining a safe distance. I would also like to emphasise that face coverings are optional and very welcome on our site should you wish to wear one.
