Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Reminders and further updates

Thank you to everyone who read all of the information sent out in July and August and has been patient and understanding at drop off and pick up. As I said in my Friday newsletter, the pupils were amazing at doing this. It is vital that all parents/carers follow the guidance.

Reminder:

1. Only one parent/carer should be coming to drop off and /or pick up.
2. No young adult/ high school age siblings should be accompanying parents/carers to collect younger siblings.
3. Pupils should not be wearing masks in school and will be asked to remove them during the day.
4. Parents/carers should not gather in groups to talk in the queue or along Noel Road.

Update:

1. **From Tuesday 8th September, we require ALL parents/carers to wear MASKS/FACE COVERING when dropping off and picking up their child. This is because it is very difficult to maintain social distancing. Therefore, please can the adult dropping off /picking up the children now wear a MASK/FACE COVERING.**
2. As I said previously and on Friday's newsletter, children will not be changing in school for PE – do not send a PE kit in and do not bring a PE kit to school if you forget your child's day. On your child's PE day they can come to school wearing their PE KIT – this should be a plain and simple PE Kit. This is not a non uniform day to wear clothes of choice or club football kits. A reminder of the kit and days can be found on the back –if they are sent to school wearing clothes of choice or club football kits children will be asked to wear their uniform and trainers.
3. A few parents have asked if they can send cakes or sweets in for their child to share with their friends on their upcoming birthday - sadly we cannot distribute food at this time. Please do not send in food to give out.

As I already said we are really grateful to everyone working with us at this difficult time – we really miss being able to meet, help and talk to you freely as we used to do. However, for the very small minority who do not follow these requests and guidance or are disrespectful to school staff, we will sadly, have to follow the Behaviour of parents/carers on site policy.
