FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Although all of KS1 (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) now qualify for the governments UIFSM. Parents need to still apply for Free School Meals as this not only benefits families but it also greatly benefits school. Information below gives information on the criteria for Free School Meals. **If you claim any of the following benefits please contact Mrs Powell on 01922 666335 who can help with the on-line process.**

Question:

Who can get free school meals?

Answer:

You can claim free school meals for your children if you are in receipt of any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance eligible for Child Tax Credit **but not** Working Tax Credit and the household income (as used by HMRC to assess tax credits) is not more than £16,190. **Please note:** anyone eligible for Working Tax Credit, or if you have a partner and they receive it, regardless of Income, you will not qualify
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit (from 30th April 2005)
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- In receipt of the 4 week run on of working tax credit (this is where someone becomes unemployed or reduces their hours and so is no longer entitled to working tax credit but will continue to receive it for a further 4 weeks and is entitled to free meals during that time) Universal credit.

COVID TESTING

Symptoms of coronavirus in children (taken from NHS website)

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

1. High temperature
2. New, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
3. Loss or change to sense of smell or taste - this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

What to do if your child has symptoms

If your child has any of the main symptoms of coronavirus you must get a test to check if they have coronavirus as soon as possible. Stay at home and do not have visitors until you get the test result - only leave your home to have a test. Anyone you live with, and anyone in your support bubble, must also stay at home until you get the result.

The fastest way to get a test result is to go to a testing site. Individuals will need a pre-booked appointment or they will not be given a test. People can also order home test kits to be sent directly to them. To book an appointment or order a home kit, please visit:
