Dear parents / carers,





Firstly, a huge thank you for your patience and understanding over the last couple of weeks. The reception children have settled incredibly well and have been accessing a wide range of exciting provision.

From next Monday (21.09.20), the reception team will be inviting the children into school on a full-time basis. The children will arrive at school from 08:45 and will begin to leave from 15:00. The drop offs will remain the same, with class teachers collecting the children from the KS1 playground from 08:45. The children will be collected from the EYFS playground in the afternoons at 15:00. Please remember to follow government guidance regarding social distancing when dropping off and collecting children.

As children will be in all day, they will be having their lunch in school. You can either send them in with a packed lunch from home, or they can have a free packed lunch from school. No children will be going home for lunch, due to the COVID-19 situation.

Your child will not be taking a reading book home for now, but we strongly advise that you still listen to your child read. Oxford Owl and Purple Mash, both have a great selection of books that can be read online.

We would like to emphasise that excellent attendance, punctuality and behaviour is vital as the children will be working at such a fast pace, we don't want them to miss a thing! Please could you ensure that your children come to school, fully prepared, in full school uniform and with pair of trainers or pumps for PE. Please remember that children should not be wearing jewellery. Could you also please provide?
