## Visit from One Day Creative

We are delighted to confirm that we have booked an in school educational visit for Stone Age drama workshops with 'One Day Creative' for Years 2, 3 and 4 on **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2020**. This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to have the chance to explore changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, as well as expressing ideas and feelings through role play and drama.
