

**AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS**

In order to maximise safety and at the same time ensure the children have as long a session as possible we have tried to match up as many of the after school clubs with the days that they have PE or swimming as they will already be changed into their PE Kit. Coloured bibs will be available so the older children will only need to bring long socks, boots & shin pads for football and tag rugby. Our Polytunnel is large enough to allow two year groups to change their footwear whilst maintaining the integrity of their individual class. Please remember if a child is unwell they should not attend school. If they develop symptoms they should get a test. Please inform school as soon as possible.

Please note that all after school clubs finish at 4.15pm unless stated otherwise

The junior children will be brought to the front of the school as is normal practice at the end of the day. They will be handed over at 4.15pm. Parents must not congregate on the playground. We will bring your children to you.

Infant children can be collected from the infant playground which again is normal practice. They can be collected at 4.15pm and we ask that you use the Round Meade gate and school path in the usual manner. Can I ask you to stay to the school path and not cut across the field where Green Park children may be playing.

We have tried to provide a range of activities where your children can enjoy developing their sports skills with their class friends in a safe environment. We will continue to look for ways to return to our normal provision only when we feel confident when it is safe to do so.

Unfortunately there will be no provision inside the school building so if the weather is severe the club will clearly not take place on that evening. Fingers crossed we enjoy some dry spells and the children will be able to enjoy these activities
