The Re-lighting of the Church is the final part of the church restoration and having received the faculty for this work from Historic Churches and permission from Diocesan Finance to spend the money we have raised for this project the electricians have been working in church since last Monday and should be finished before the end of September. There are two main reasons for the re-lighting; first of all many of the old lights need replacing and we need scaffolding to do the work which is very expensive and secondly the new lights today are called LED and last for a long time, using very little electricity and we are able to focus the spot lights to illuminate the shrines & statues and at the same time have a clear but soft light in the church.

We welcome one of the Comboni Missionary Fathers to St. Anne's this weekend as the celebrant and preacher at Holy Mass for the Saturday Vigil and Sunday morning.

The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows dates back to the twelfth century and Pope Pius X fixed the permanent date of 15th September the day after the Holy Cross which reminds us of the suffering of Mary during the passion and death of Christ. This feast refers to all the sorrows of Mary, as indicated by the words of Simeon: "And your own soul a sword shall pierce." In our own times of suffering we can come to Our Lady and ask for her help & prayers.

Please Note: No Mass on Monday morning this week but then all Masses at the usual times.
