The children have now been given their I-pads. Could you please ensure that they are fully charged each night, before they are brought back in to school.

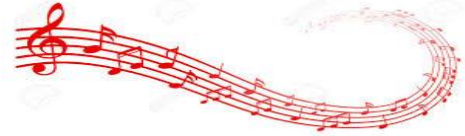
Flu Vaccinations
