Data Collection Forms

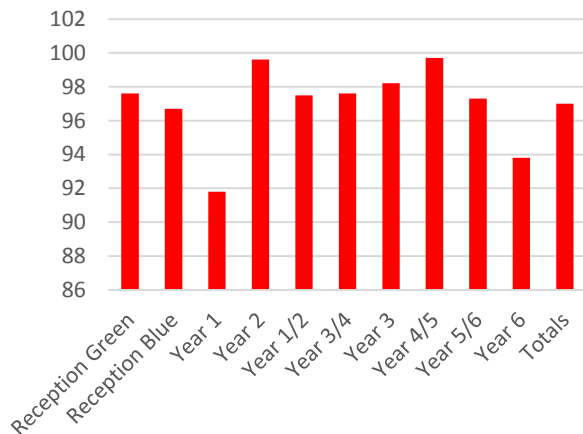
This week we will be distributing the Data Collection forms. Please make sure we have your correct details and any medical conditions you wish to include.

Holiday Club

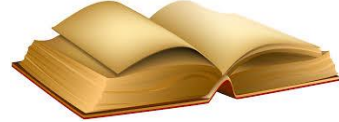

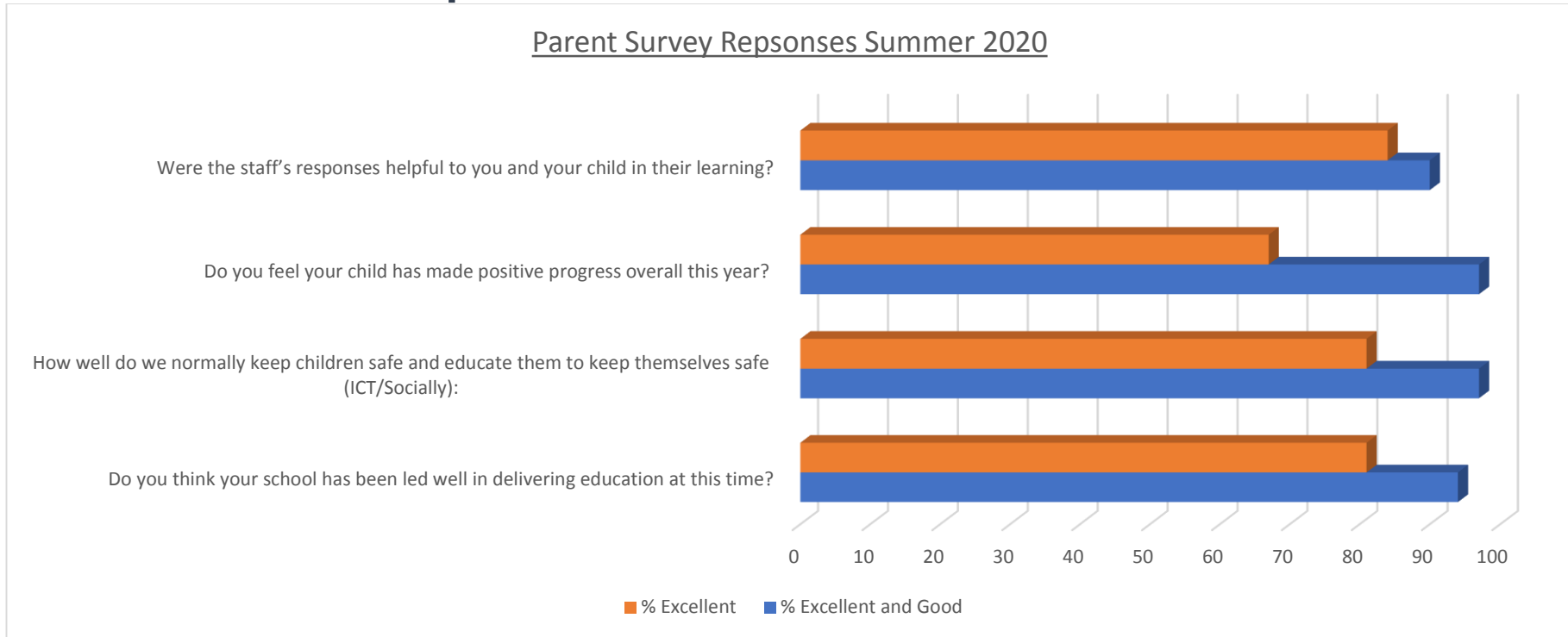
