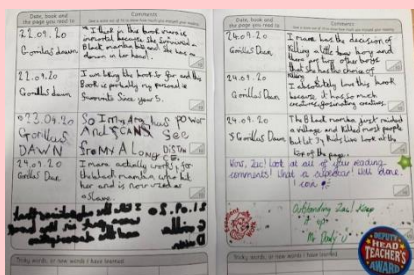
# CELEBRATION NEWSLETTER
