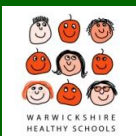

## COVID Measures and Winter Weather



This week we have seen the temperatures tumble and the rain return. With this in mind, we have moved our drop off system onto winter mode! Instead of standing in inclement weather, children come through the gate at their time and go straight into school, maintaining their bubbles. We have practised this for a couple of days and it has worked well.

Within our classrooms we have been keeping windows and doors open to ensure plenty of ventilation and also to minimize touch points. The class teachers will now change this practice in accordance with the temperature. Whilst we keep doors from the classroom to the corridors open, we now close the external classroom doors and windows. When the children go out to play, we are opening them again for a period of ventilation. If children are cold, the teachers are allowing children to wear their outdoor clothing if they would like to. Some children are wearing vests under their uniform for extra warmth and we would encourage this, if your child is feeling the cold.



Please would you make sure your child has a warm, waterproof coat in school every day? The class teachers are taking them out for fresh air every day.
